## **PCO Preflight Checklist**

Identify problems early, where and when you can more easily deal with them.

HAND SPRAYERS  □ Puddle under sprayer? □ Visual inspection. □ Pressure test. □ Spray test for leaks, pattern, etc.
TANK  ☐ Check for leaks, especially around fittings ☐ Check that tank is secure. ☐ Check for debris. ☐ Lid present and secure?
LINE STRAINER/FILTER  ☐ Open and clean out debris in screen. ☐ Check O-ring for swelling.
GAS ENGINE  □ Gas/oil properly filled? □ Gas cap secure? □ Oil leaks? □ Check belt for wear/snugness. □ Check pull cord for excessive wear. □ Check recoil for proper rewind action.
PUMP  ☐ Staining or evidence of leaks? ☐ Visible leaks? ☐ Pump specific problems, such as: diaphragm pump oil reservoir contamination?
SUPPLY/FEEDER HOSES  Leaks? Excessive wear or bubbling? Kinks? Fittings in good condition? Clamps snug/hoses secure?
HOSE REEL/SPRAY HOSE  Puddle under reel/hose/gun?  Reel lock operational?  Reel turns properly?  Unwind 20-30 feet of hose.

PRESSURE TEST
☐ Start up power sprayer.
☐ Check for abnormal sounds.
$\Box$ Check entire system for leaks.
☐ Electric pump:
$\square$ Evidence of power to pump.
☐ Gas Pump:
$\ \square$ Belts/pulleys aligned.
$\square$ Belts/pulleys turn OK.
SPRAY TEST
$\square$ Test gun by spraying back into tank.
☐ Pressure OK?
☐ Flow rate OK?
$\square$ Spray pattern OK?
$\ \square$ Rewind hose (manual/electric) to ensure
proper reel operation.
INSPECT OTHER SPECIALIZED or CUSTOM EQUIPMENT
$\square$ Proper operation.
☐ No leaks.
$\square$ Load security.
